Pre-Entry deadline is Oct. 13, 2018

Pre-entries received without payment are not complete. An emailed entry will not reserve a place. Checks and money orders will be deposited when received.

Pre-Entry = 1 to 3 runs: \$20.00 per class

Pre-Entry Weekend Special = 4+ runs: \$18.00 per class

Four entries with the same dog = \$72.00

Pre-Entry Senior (55+) = 1 to 3 runs: \$18.00 per class

Pre-Entry Senior (55+) Weekend Special = 4+ runs: \$16.00 per class

Four entries with the same dog = \$64.00

Junior (age 17 or younger) Entry Fee = Any number: \$10 per class

Day of Show Entry Fee - \$25.00 per class, no multi-run discounts

Day of Show Entries for Trial 1 and Trial 2 will be accepted each day from 7:30 AM - 8:30 AM. Day of Show Entries for Trial 2 only will be accepted any time prior to Trial 2.

Exhibitors planning to enter Day of Show should check with the trial secretary prior to the trial weekend to ensure that the trials have not filled.

Please note that when an email address is provided on the entry form, electronic confirmations will be sent in lieu of paper.

Directions to Site:

I-81 to Exit 57 (PA Route 114); proceed north on Route 114 approximately 1 mile. At the signal light at the intersection of Routes 114 and 944 (Wertzville Road) go straight, take the second right past the signal turn in the lot. The OTCH building is the cream-colored building with a green stripe behind the Rite Aid Pharmacy.

Setting your GPS device to the street address is pretty reliable: 1 Souder Court, Mechanicsburg, PA

Where to stay

(As of Sept. 10, 2017: Call to verify dogs are still accepted; ask when reserving or checking in if a discount is offered for OTCH events. We're working on getting special rates.)

Holiday Inn Express (4.4 mi. from trial site) 6325 Carlisle Pike, Mechanicsburg, PA 17050; (717) 790-0924. **Mention OTCH** for a price of \$92.65 (with tax) and only one dog charge; free breakfast included. Directions: from the hotel, turn right onto US11 West, go 1.4 miles, turn right on Route 114. More directions below.

Park Inn (5 miles from trial site) 5401 Carlisle Pike, Mechanicsburg PA 17050 / (717) 697-0321. Directions: from I-81 exit 59, take Route 114 south to US 11. Turn left on to US 11 for 3 miles to the Holiday Inn on your left.

Hampton Inn Carlisle (7 miles from the trial site)

1164 Harrisburg Pike, Carlisle, PA 17013 (717) 240-0200 Directions: From I-81 North - Take Exit 52B and make a right, go about one mile and the hotel is on the right-hand side. From I-81 South - Take Exit 52 and make a right, go about one mile and the hotel is on the right-hand side. From PA Turnpike - Take Exit 226, continue straight, north towards Harrisburg hotel is across from exit ramp on the left. You will be able to see the hotel from the exit ramp, but you can not make a left-hand turn from the traffic light, turn right in the Pilot Travel parking lot - go through lot make left out of lot and go straight through light.

Entry Limits

If entry limit of **60** dogs each day is reached before pre-entries close, a wait list will be established, based on postmark date.

All entry forms must be complete and fully legible. Incomplete or illegible entry forms do not constitute valid entries and will be returned.

Returned Check Policy

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 10 days of notice to exhibitor of returned check. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.

Conduct

Exhibitors are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. Any exhibitor exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be declared ineligible and asked to leave the premises.

Accessibility

Owners with disabilities are encouraged to enter. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.

Awards in each trial:

High in Trial: Rosette; embroidered item created and donated by Rhonda Robinson.

High Combined: Rosette.

The High in Trial and High Combined are drawn only from the Versatility, Utility, Open, and Novice classes.

High Starter Novice (from any class): item donated by Jacki Latimore.

1st-4th place: Rosette.

A qualifying ribbon will be presented to all qualifiers.

Trial 2 will begin at the conclusion of Trial 1, or at 11:30 a.m., whichever is later.

Exhibitors are expected to be ready at ringside when their number is called. Judges will not delay judging for any exhibitor not ready when called.

Move-ups: Move ups may be made into (1) a higher level "A" class on the same day that an exhibitor believes the third qualifying score in the lower level class has been earned or (2) the "C" class of the same level. The Exhibitor, Trial Representative, and Trial Host must complete and/or sign the Class Move Up form. Information on the Class Move Up form must be legible and complete. If information is illegible and/or incomplete, the Trial Host is not permitted to honor the request and/or process the form.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of CDSP rules and regulations (see www.companiondogsportsprogram.com), including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- This trial is open to a dog at least six months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries, or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.
- Dogs must be shown by a member of the owner's immediate family: mother, father, spouse, life partner, sibling, child, grandparent, or grandchild.
- All dogs shall be shown in a flat buckle or snap collar, or properly fitted Martingale (limited slip) collar. No choke collar, prong collars, shock collars, harnesses, Martingale leads, or head collars are allowed. (See full rules for health exceptions for harnesses. Veterinarian letter is required.)
- All dogs must be registered with CDSP on the day of competition. See <u>www.companiondogsportsprogram.com</u> to complete the registration form and submit it to the CDSP office.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- Any dog removed from the premises for aggressive or threatening behavior is not eligible for a refund and not eligible for any placements and/or awards.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.
- Refunds for females in season will be given upon receipt of a statement by the exhibitor's veterinarian, less a \$5.00 processing fee.
- No refunds will be given after close of pre-entries on Aug. 11, 2018.
 A \$5.00 handling fee will be deducted from the refund of entries that are withdrawn prior to the closing date (other than those for females in season).
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- All competitors through entry at this event grant to Companion Dog Sports Program, their representatives, agents, and assigns, all rights and permissions to use or appropriate the exhibitor's and the dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia or identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission, or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known and waive any and all rights relative thereto.

Please allow at least two weeks for receipt via email or 4-6 weeks for receipt via regular mail.

Which Class Do I Enter? A, B, and C Classes Explained

- Starter Novice A: Shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.
- Starter Novice B: Shall be for dogs who have earned a Beginner Novice (BN) obedience title or equivalent in any registry and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.
- Starter Novice C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Starter Novice title (SN-C) in either the A or B class and does not have a qualifying score (Q) in Novice in any obedience registry.
- *Novice A:* Shall be for dogs who have not earned any other obedience title in any registry.
- *Novice B:* Shall be for dogs who have earned an obedience title in any registry, including Starter Novice (SN-C).
- Novice C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Novice title (CD-C) in either the A or B class.
- *Open A:* Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C).
- Open B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice obedience title (CD-C) and/or any other Open obedience titles in any registry.
- *Open C:* Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Open title (CDX-C) in either the A or B class.
- Utility A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Open obedience title (CDX-C).
- Utility B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Utility obedience title (UD-C) and who wish to earn a CDSP Utility Dog Excellent title (UDX-C) and a CDSP Obedience Trial Championship title (OTCH-C).
- Utility C: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Utility obedience title (UD-C) and who wish to earn the CDSP Utility Championship obedience title (UD-CCH).
- Versatility A: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice title (CD-C).
- Versatility B: Shall be for dogs who have earned the CDSP Novice title (CD-C) and any other Open or Utility qualifying leg or obedience title in any registry.
- Versatility C: Shall be for dogs who have earned a CDSP Versatility title (VT-C) in either the A or B class.

All competitors through entry at this event grant to Companion Dog Sports Program, their representatives, agents, and assigns, hereby release CDSP, the hosting club, their representatives, agents, and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of personality, or any similar right.

- Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes.
- Dogs must remain under control and on leash at all times while on trial site grounds. Please pick up after your dog and yourself

Jump Heights

Dogs are not required to be measured the day of the trial or prior to judging. However, judges have the option to measure any dog prior to his/her performance if the dog appears to be entered in a group lower than might be indicated by his/her registered shoulder height. Jump heights may also be modified based on physical challenges that a particular dog may face.

Veteran dogs (seven years and older) may jump 2" lower than regular jump height indicated on above chart. An Exercise Modification Form is not required. Check "Vet" on your entry form and enter the veteran jump height.

Note: If modifying your dog's jump height, select the <u>modified height</u> on your entry and check the box to indicate modified height. You must also submit an Exercise Modification Form to be signed by the trial judge and attached to your score sheet. An Exercise Modification Form must be completed for <u>each</u> trial. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry. of the holding of the event, and of the opportunity to have the dog participate and/or to be judged, I (we) agree to hold the organizing committee, the hosting club, OTCH, including their members, officers, directors, agents and employees, sponsors of the event, and owners of the premises upon which the event is held and their employees, harmless from any claim for loss or injury that may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, appearance, theft, damage, or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
